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By-Law No. 114

A Bylaw to Ensure Fire Hydrant Clearance and Access to Water Operation Boxes and Valves

- 1) All fire hydrants are installed on public property. In order to ensure access to fire hydrants, no person shall plant, erect or cause to plant or erect any structure or materials within a three (3) metre diameter of the fire hydrant.
- 2) All water operations boxes and valves (e.g. resident service boxes, system valve boxes, system air release valve boxes, water sampling boxes, etc.) are on public property. In order to ensure clear access to water operations boxes and valves, no person shall plant, erect or cause to plant or erect any structure or materials that would prevent or limit clear access to these boxes and valves.
- 3) Ships Point Improvement District (SPID) is responsible for determining required clearances and clear access referred to in 1) and 2) above.
- 4) Ships Point Improvement District (SPID) is responsible for maintaining the clearance and access referred to in 1) and 2) above.
- 5) Any person(s) determined to have planted, erected or caused to plant or erect any structure or materials on public lands that impedes the clearance and access referred to in 3) and 4) shall be responsible for the cost of the work of clearance of such plants or structure or materials.
