

SHIPS POINT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BYLAW 127


A bylaw for fixing the connection charge payable to the District and the time of payment thereof.

The Trustees of Ships Point Improvement District ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Definitions:**
 - a. Service Connection:
Shall mean the pipeline installation from the District's main to the property line of the property to be serviced when such property line coincides with the established road allowance.
 - b. Service Pipe:
Shall mean the pipeline installation from the curb stop at the property line to the premises of the owner.
2. Application for Water
 - a. Application for water shall be made in writing to the Trustees, delivered to the District Administrator, and shall be in such form as the Trustees may from time to time prescribe, and shall be signed by the applicant.
 - b. Each application for water shall be accompanied by the prescribed administration and inspection charge as set in this bylaw.
 - c. No water shall be supplied upon application, until all fees and charges for water connection, meter installation or other monies required by the Trustees to be paid have been paid in full or by until alternative arrangements have been made and approved by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Connection Charge:
There shall be payable to the District by every applicant for a connection to the works, an inspection and administration charge of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), plus the total cost of labour, materials, permits and other items required to install the service connection.
4. All service connections and service pipelines installed under this bylaw shall conform to such specifications and shall incorporate such materials as shall be determined and approved by the District or their representative.
5. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Connection Charge Bylaw 2025" and repeals Bylaw 55 passed by the Trustees on October 11, 2000 and registered by the Deputy Inspector of Municipalities on November 21st, 2000.
